

## **PATH 2011 March Worktrip/Volunteers Report**

It was a great work week with some great weather and a cold Saturday. We had 37 workers for the week and 32 on Saturday. We had a total of 104 Volunteer Workdays. Thanks to everyone who participated in making it a success. All the trail was covered and we only have 10-12 blow downs on Brushy Mt. (622-86) to cut in April.

Special thanks goes out to those monitors that did their monitoring beforehand, and to Harry, Will, Jim, Karl, and Chris for cutting the blow downs and planning the evening meal.

Thanks to all of those that worked and Saturday and came up early during the week.

Work Accomplished for the week:

Fri, Sat, Sun: RPC Meeting in Hendersonville (Bill, Jim)

Sun: met Harry at KFC in Marion

Mon: Bill, Jim and Harry- Hiked 623 to Wilderness and cut blow downs and back tracked to Davis Farm. Jim Hiked thru to 615.

Bill drops Chris off at 615 to walk and clear N to I-77/52/21

All camped Mon. evening at Walker Gap, while there we installed new trail sign at new water source.

Tue: Bill, Jim and Harry- Harry walked to Chestnut Ridge Shelter cutting along the way and putting new lock on the ladder and later joining Bill and Jim at new water source N of Walker Gap. Blazed new water source and new AT.

Deblazed 100 ft of old AT and next year will blue blaze it as a side trail to a winter view. Cleaned out COFFIN Cistern and put a collection bucket in place. (blue blazed) On the way out cut Dwight's blow down on Garden Mt. Camped in Poor Valley.

Wed: Bill, Jim, Harry cut blow downs and debriared AT from 222 to Lynn Camp Mt. We also looked at bridge and the blow downs in Lick Creek. Jim and Harry also cleared the AT parking lot of debris and briars. Went food shopping

in Marion and Camped at Sugar Grove that evening.
