



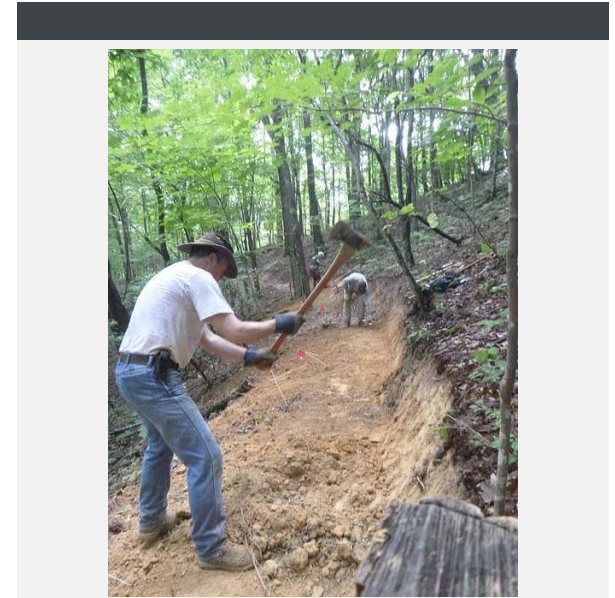
Appalachian Trail maintenance with Piedmont Appalachian Trail Hikers!
