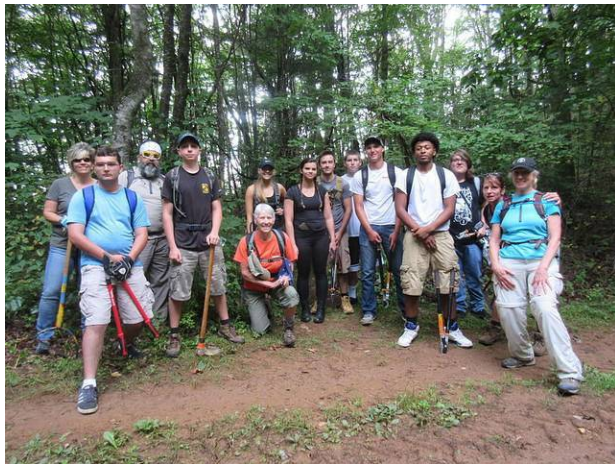




## *Appalachian Trail Maintenance with Piedmont Appalachian Trail Hikers*
